
## Copy and Paste Data as a Picture

### Kingsoft Spreadsheet 2013

1. Open a workbook in Spreadsheets 2013.
2. Press Ctrl+C to copy a selected range of data.



3. Place the cursor where you want to insert the copied content as a picture.
4. Go to Home tab > Paste > Paste as picture. See below:



### MS Excel 2007

1. Select the range you want to copy.
2. In the Home tab, Clipboard group, click Copy.
3. Select a cell in the range where you want to paste the picture.
4. In the Home tab, Clipboard group, click on the arrow below the Paste icon, point to As Picture and click Paste as Picture.



5. The pasted picture will look like similar to below:  
 TIP: Try unchecking the grid under View tab to remove the excess gray lines when pasting as a picture.
